(Sepia can be made by mixing burnt umber and black)</li> <li>No black, white or other colors allowed in the picture.</li> <li>Entry cannot be products of workshops, classes, or any other supervised gathering either at Pine Shores or any other art association.</li> <li>Entry cannot be a copy of someone else's painting. They cannot duplicate a picture from a magazine, calendar, internet or other commercially published work.</li> </ul>
