Guidelines	 Fairy tales, Myths and Legends fills us with fantasy. Make it original, make it your own. Entry cannot be used from any movie, book, anime, etc or someone else's painting. (Examples: Alice in Wonderland, Star Wars, Dragon Ball, etc) They cannot duplicate a picture from a magazine, calendar, internet or other commercially published work. Political, controversial social commentary, pornographic nudes (artistic nudes accepted), or graphic violence type entry will not be accepted. Entry acceptance decided by the discretion of the Galley Committee. Entry cannot be products of workshops, classes, or any other supervised gathering, either at Pine Shores or any other art association and has never been displayed in another PSAA Gallery show.
