#### Columbia's Italian Stuffing

**Ingredients:**  
 2 lbs. sweet Italian sausage  
 (simmered and sautéed)  
 1/2 lb. garbanzo (not roasted & chopped)  
 1 lb. mushrooms (sautéed in butter &  
 garlic pieces)  
 1/2 lb. chestnuts (roasted & kept in  
 large pieces)  
 1 cup chopped walnuts  
 3 leaves stuffing bread  
 2 small boxes of raisins  
 10 figs (chopped)  
 1 cup cubed pepperoni  
 4 eggs  
 Almost 1 bunch of celery-liced  
 1 large onion (chopped)  
 Sage, thyme, nutmeg, oregano to  
 taste  
 Grated parmesan cheese  
 Chicken broth as needed

**Method:**  
 Sauté celery and onions  
 Add other prepared ingredients

For 20 lb. turkey
