### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE By Nancy Edwards

"A work is finished when an artist realizes his intentions." Rembrandt

What story do you want your work tell? Do you sit down to paint or draw without knowing where you are going? It is not uncommon for artists to rush to start painting, without taking the necessary steps to plan their work. What do you want your art to say? What story are you inviting your viewers to be part of? What time of day is it? Where is the sun? How do you accomplish showing distance? Do you do a few value studies? The more you take the time to plan, the better your end result will be. Trying to correct your art midway, is more difficult than planning it out in advance.

In my training with Tom Lynch, he always stressed value studies. And how focusing on your lights and darks make your work pop! Think about your focal point...does your eye move right to it? Do you have strong contrast there, possibly brighter colors?

Take your time to plan...and better yet...know when you are done! Be careful not to overwork!

We are not kidding when we say we need new volunteers to step up. Many positions established with set terms are coming to an end this year and numerous volunteers of critical areas are stepping down, or into new and different areas. Without people to fill these positions, there is no PSAA as we are a 100% volunteer run organization.

To say "Just hire someone to do the job," isn't that easy. First, we don't have finances to pay for all these areas. Second, being a not – for-profit organization limits us in what paid positions can be offered. Then there's the debate of where will the money come from? Raise prices? Downsize and eliminate benefits? Both?

While the Board is still reviewing suggestions, outcomes, and options presented at the meeting, several people (members and Non-member Friends alike) did step up to offer help.
