Holiday Art Boxes for Kids Were a Big Hit!

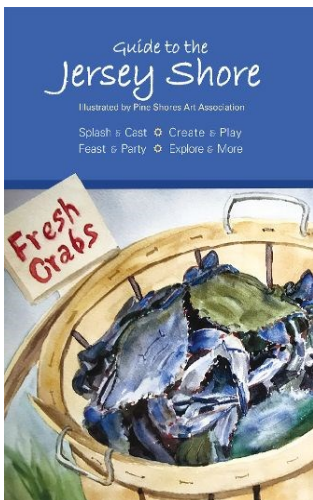
