Awards will be posted on June 15. **This is a special opportunity for non-professional artists to show their talents.** A non-pro is defined here as not selling more than \$400 in art during the year; not being paid to teach or demonstrate art; not winning more than six art awards; not having work accepted for two or more juried shows; not receiving a "Signature" or other equally high membership status in any art organization; or not ever having full- or part-time employment as an artist. If none of these apply to you, please enter the Novice Show. We want to recognize your fine work.

July – Spring-ish Art Show, originally planned for May, the annual Spring Show is rescheduled for July, when we hope to be open and back again in our studio gallery. See the attached flyer for details.

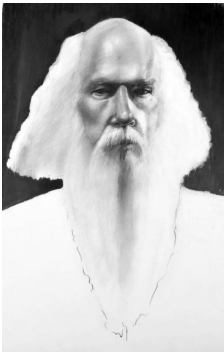

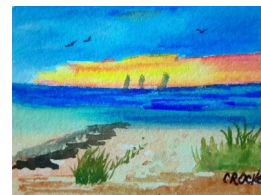
