JUNE Featured Artists: Maryellen Wernick and Valentin AvilaWhen you grow up always drawing or creating something crafty, and you

are a nurturer with great rapport with kids, teaching art becomes a wonderful career. Maryellen Wernick's high school teacher recognized these gifts and mentored her. She graduated from King's College as a Fine Arts Education major and taught art in Edison to over 500 kids a week for 33 years, mostly in grades K-6.

In retirement, Maryellen loves to work in many mediums--watercolor, gouache, charcoal, pen and ink, but her favorite is graphite drawing. An avid student in Tom Rutledge classes, Maryellen's style is realistic. Look for detail work and texture in her subject matter--"rusty-crusty" peeling paint objects and scenes.

Complementing Maryellen's exhibit is the work of Valentin Avila, a dedicated five-hour-a-day painter. His subject matter can be anything-portraits, sea and landscapes, street scenes, animals--whatever he finds interesting at the time. His style is eclectic, ranging from realism to abstract to surrealism and currently, impressionism. Oil is his usual medium, but he also enjoys watercolor and pastels. Valentin's education includes four years at the Academia d'Arte in Florence, Italy, to learn the techniques of the Old Masters. He studies, exhibits and sells in Florida and New Jersey and accepts commissions.
